In this [ACTION](#) webinar, participants will learn about **7 steps for developing effective and human rights-based 10-Point Plans of Action (10-PPAs)**, as derived from the unique structure of the [Toolkit for Equality \(TKE\)](#). The 7 steps cover essential topics and processes relevant to the development of 10-PPAs, such as identifying and engaging relevant actors, structurally embedding an action plan in the city administration, or increasing the resilience of action plans.

In addition, webinar participants will have the opportunity to engage in a peer-to-peer exchange. In a first round of discussions, participants are invited to **share their experiences** and the **challenges** they face as local authorities and city administrators. In a second round, **good practice approaches** to common challenges will be discussed. The webinar will conclude with an insight into the best practices identified in the framework of the ACTION project.
